Champion Scholarship for Business Students (AY2025-26)

The School of Business is committed to nurturing future leaders with professional business knowledge and all-round competence. In particular, the School has been supporting students to gain practical experience and sharpen both analytical and communication skills through open competitions. The “Champion Scholarship for Business Students” is established to encourage students to actively participate in business-related competitions and to award those who have achieved triumph in the end.

DETAILS

Business students who won champion in competition recognized by the School of Business, depending on the level (international / regional / national / local) and the format (one-off / knockout), will be given a scholarship of maximum HK\$6,000 and a Certificate of Merit per student as encouragement. Scholarship amount of different level and format of competition is presented in the following tables:

One-off Competition

Level \ Format	Maximum Amount of Scholarship per student	Maximum Amount of Scholarship per team
International	HK\$ 4,000	HK\$ 20,000
Regional	HK\$ 3,000	HK \$15,000
National/Local	HK\$ 2,000	HK \$10,000

Knockout Competition[#]

[#]“Knockout competition” here denotes competitions which comprise different levels of contests. The winner in the lowest level will proceed to the next level to compete for the championship. A champion in a knockout competition shall only receive the scholarship amount for the highest level of competition at which he/she is named the champion.

Level \ Format	Maximum Amount of Scholarship per student	Maximum Amount of Scholarship per team
International Level (proceed from Regional Level)	HK\$ 6,000	HK \$30,000
Regional Level (proceed from National/Local Level but fail to advance to International Level or there is no International Level)	HK\$ 4,000	HK \$20,000
National/Local Level (fail to proceed to Regional Level or there is no Regional Level)	HK\$ 2,000	HK \$10,000

AWARDING CRITERIA

1. Applicants should be UGC funded or self-funded undergraduate HKBU Business students.
2. Applicants should be awarded champion in an international/regional/national/local business-related competition recognized by the School (please refer to the reference list of business-related competitions recognized by the School below)
3. (a) Applicants who won champion **on individual basis** would be awarded a scholarship amount of HK\$2,000 - \$6,000, subject to the level/ format of the competition, as listed in the above tables.
 (b) Applicants who won champion **on team basis** would be awarded a scholarship amount of HK\$2,000 - \$6,000, subject to the level/ format of the competition, as listed in the above tables; or the “Maximum Amount of Scholarship per team” ÷ the number of eligible team members, whichever is lower. For example, a local level competition champion team consists of 3 eligible team members would be awarded HK\$2,000 per student (a max. of HK\$2,000 per student); a local level competition champion team consists of 6 eligible team members would be awarded HK\$1,666.67 per student (a max. of HK\$10,000 per team).

APPLICATION

Applicants should submit the following documents to BBA / BCom Programme Office:

- a. A completed Application Form (downloadable from BBA website)
- b. A copy of supporting documents, i.e. the award certificate issued by the competition organization, champion award received.

For BBA students

Completed application form should be submitted to **Mr. Anson Lam** at WLB801 or by email.

For BCom students

Completed application form should be submitted to the corresponding programme office.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are accepted all year round. For Academic Year 2025-26, students who receive a champion award from 1 Sept 2025 to 31 Aug 2026 are eligible to apply. Students should submit an application within 2 months upon receiving a champion award.

PANEL INTERVIEW

Qualified applicants may be invited to interview presided by BBA / BCom directors. The School reserves the right to make the final decision.
