Competition Winning Students Award (AY2024-25)

The School of Business has always been encouraging students to take part in various Business competitions to apply knowledge into practices. The “Competition Winning Students Award” is proposed to show recognition and appreciation to students who have been devoting effort and time to challenge themselves in recognized business competitions and achieve good result.

DETAILS

Business students who achieved outstanding ranking in competition recognized by the School of Business, will be given a cash award and a Certificate of Merit per student as encouragement. Award amount is presented in the following table:

Achievement	Maximum Amount of Award per student	Maximum Amount of Award per team
1st Runner-up/2nd Runner-up/3rd Runner-up; Silver Award/Bronze Award; or any awards recognized by the School	HK\$ 1,000	HK\$ 5,000

AWARDING CRITERIA

1. Applicants should be UGC funded or self-funded undergraduate HKBU Business students.
2. Applicants should be awarded outstanding ranking (1st Runner-up/2nd Runner-up/3rd Runner-up, Silver Award/Bronze Award or any awards recognized by the School) in a business-related competition recognized by the School (please refer to the reference list of business-related competitions recognized by the School below)
3. (a) Applicants who achieved outstanding ranking **on individual basis** would be awarded an amount of HK\$1,000, as shown in the “Maximum Amount of Award per student”.
(b) Applicants who achieved outstanding ranking **on team basis** would be awarded an amount of HK\$1,000, or the amount shown in “Maximum Amount of Award per team” ÷ the number of eligible team members, whichever is lower. For example, a winning team consists of 3 eligible team members would be awarded HK\$1,000 per student (a max. of HK\$1,000 per student); a winning team consists of 6 eligible team members would be awarded HK\$833.33 per student (a max. of HK\$5,000 per team).

APPLICATION

Applicants should submit the following documents to BBA / BCom Programme Office:

- a. A completed Application Form (downloadable at BBA website)
- b. A copy of valid supporting documents, i.e. the award certificate issued by the competition organization, for the outstanding award received.

For BBA students

The completed application form should be submitted to **Mr. Anson Lam** at WLB801 or by email.

For BCom students

Completed application form should be submitted to the corresponding programme office.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are accepted all year round. For Academic Year 2024-25, students who achieve outstanding rankings from 1 Sept 2024 to 31 Aug 2025 are eligible to apply. Students should submit an application within 2 months of receiving the award.

PANEL INTERVIEW

Qualified applicants may be invited to interview presided by BBA / BCom directors. The School reserves the right to make the final decision.
