e-Learning Award Scheme for BBA Students

AIMS

Self e-Learning is one of the graduation requirements for BBA students from the class of 2023/24 onwards. To encourage all BBA students to make good use of this online learning platform, BBA Programme Office has established two learning awards. The primary selection criterion is the study records on LinkedIn Learning of the applicants, while their services to the University/School and/or participation in extra-curricular activities related to e-Learning will also be considered.

ELIGIBILITY and PROCEDURE

The e-Learning Award Scheme comprises two different awards: the “*Engagement Award*” and the “*Leading e-Learners Award*”. The specific selection criteria and procedures for the individual awards vary, but the general criteria are:

1. Current BBA students.
2. Maintain constant learning records via LinkedIn Learning.
3. Be active in BBA e-Learning related activities.

➤ **Engagement Award**

This award is designed to enhance students’ engagement with the e-Learning platform and to encourage the sharing of good e-Learning resources within the BBA Community. The awardees will receive a \$250 gift card. To be eligible for the award, students need to

- Provide a recommendation for one or more LinkedIn Learning Courses, with proven learning records, in a write-up of no less than 200 words. Selected recommendations will be shared to BBA social media platforms, website and other appropriate platforms for promotion purposes.

The application is open throughout the academic year, from September to April. Awardees will be selected monthly based on their submission period. Any submissions received after 15th of the month will be considered in the subsequent month.

➤ **Leading e-Learners Award**

This award is designed to recognize students who have outstanding achievement in self e-Learning.

The awards will be granted to a total of 10 recipients. The level at which awards are received will be determined by the recipients' eligibility and the quality of the reflection. All recipients will receive a certificate of merit, and monetary awards will be distributed as follows based on ranking:
